

GRANPAINT

Polyurethane Games Line Paint for Wooden Sports Floors

DESCRIPTION: Granpaint is a hard wearing two pack polyurethane paint, designed for use in conjunction with either **Granwax Classical Sport** or **Granwax Masterfinish Sport** to provide a fast and effective system for court line markings on wooden and sprung wooden floors. Please note Classical Sport is recommended for light use and Masterfinish Sport should be used for heavy floor usage (sports & leisure centres).

INITIAL PREPARATION & APPLICATION OF FINISH: On new or refurbished wood or wood sprung floors, the surface must be prepared to a smooth, even finish, and all traces of dust and debris removed prior to applying the chosen finish using a suitable applicator and pad. Under normal specification, the floor should initially receive one coat of finish but for heavy usage, two initial coats are recommended.

Allow finish to dry overnight before abrading the entire surface using 100grit abrasive in order to provide a physical 'key' prior to the application of paint lines and further coats of finish.

PAINT APPLICATION: After removing all traces of dust and debris by vacuuming and 'tack-rag' method, set out court markings with Granwax masking tape. Granpaint should be mixed with hardener according to label. Important: Hardener (Part B) is quite viscous; please ensure it is all removed from container when adding to Base (Part A).

Mix very well with wooden spatula supplied. Apply by paint brush, synthetic pad or suitable roller. Paint must be applied evenly to avoid pooling or drip marks which will detract from the overall appearance of the floor.

PLEASE NOTE: Masking tape should be removed no later than 15 minutes after application of Granpaint to avoid the tape becoming 'sealed-in' or leaving jagged edges.

OVERCOATING: Granpaint may be overcoated with chosen finish as soon as the paint is tack-free (approximately 4 – 6 hours). If Granpaint is to be left longer than this period, it must be lightly abraded with 150 grit* sandscreen disc or paper, prior to receiving further applications of finish. **Grit grades are offered as a guide only. Operatives must ensure sufficient 'key' is created to enable successful adhesion of paint and finish.*

Normally, two coats of finish are recommended over the lines to ensure good protection and colour enhancement of the paint.
